## **Promoting Fecal Sludge and Septage Management in Tamil Nadu:**

### **Introduction**

The two-day programme on Orientation cum Training Programme for Promoting Fecal Sludge and Septage Management, is targeted at Officers working in State level agencies, ULBs, and selected Utilities. This programme will draw upon international and national examples and experiences, dwell upon developments in the State, and help participants understand the operational/practical aspects of planning, implementing and monitoring the elements of full chain of urban sanitation, especially focusing on Fecal Sludge and Septage Management (FSSM) as comprehensive solutions for small and medium towns, and complementary solutions for larger urban areas.

### **Learning Objectives**

1. To create awareness on the policies/guidelines and practices about FSSM from international best practices and experiments in India and TN (incl. Operative Guidelines)
2. To enable participants to discuss the key issues and constraints in prioritizing and promoting solutions and innovations for urban sanitation in TN, and help develop recommendations
3. To help participants to develop action plans at State and regional levels focussing on identified ULBs
