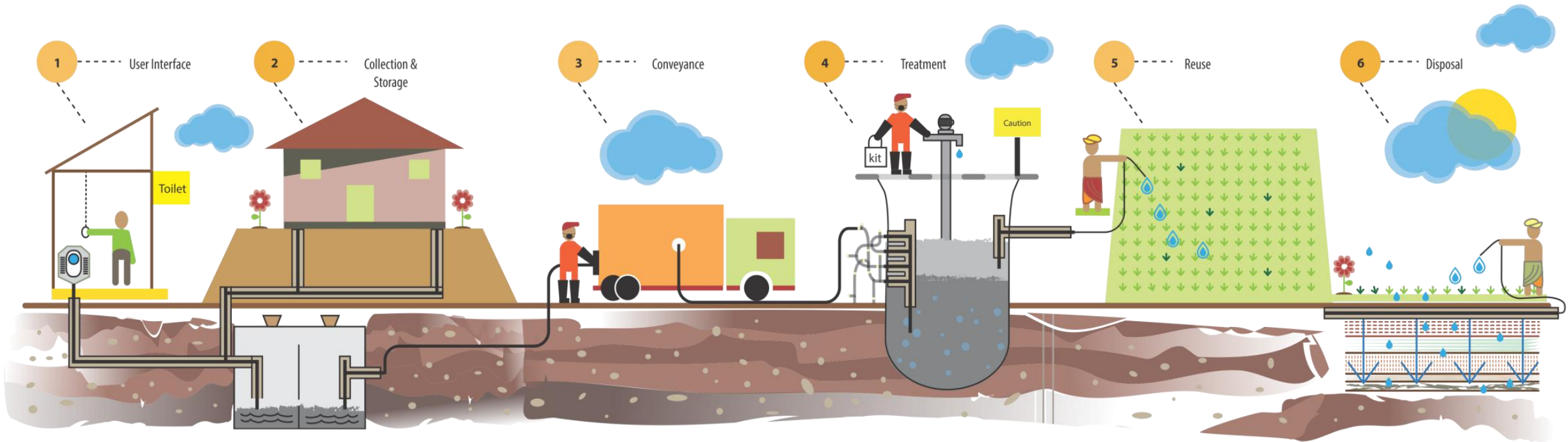

Sanitation Value Chain



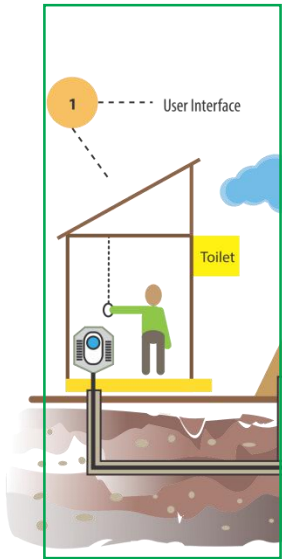
Toilet (user interface)

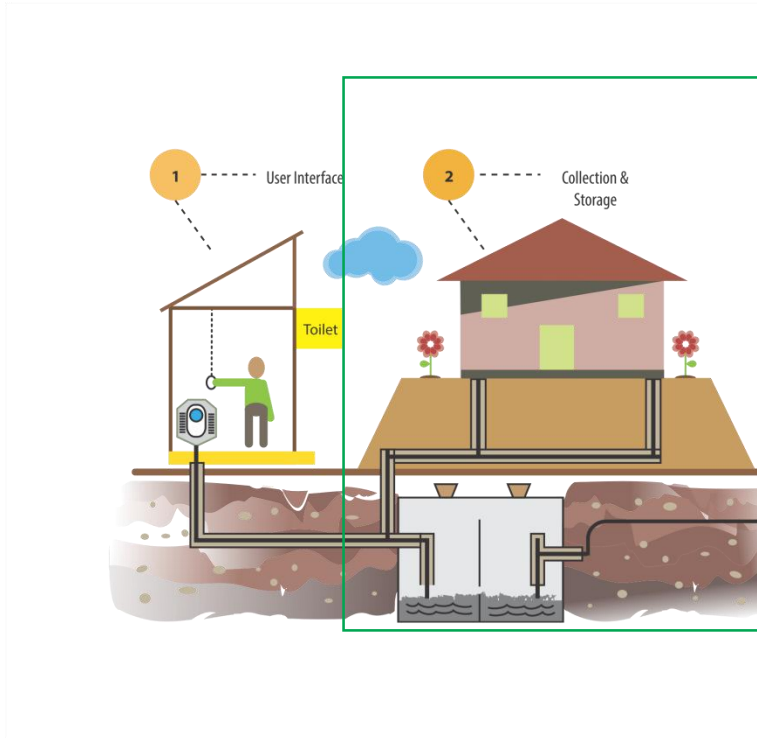

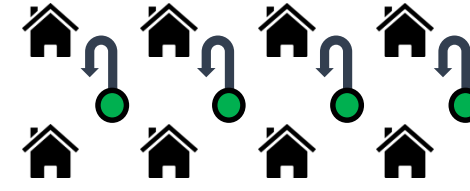


Onsite vs Offsite treatment systems

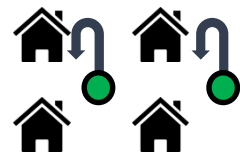
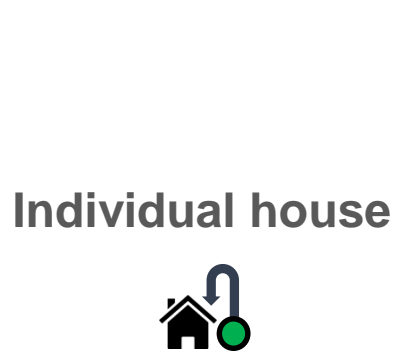


Off-site treatment is the treatment of wastewater that has been conveyed using a sewerage system

“On-Site treatment system stores and treats the excreta at the point of generation”

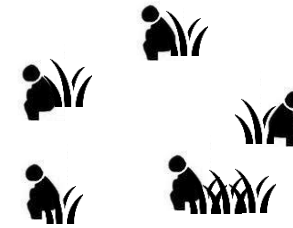
Potential for onsite sanitation systems



No. of Household in India= 24.7 crores



No. of Household in India with no toilet = 13.1 crores (53%)



No. of Household in India with in house toilet = 11.6 crores (47%)
